Orientation

Orientation & Appreciation Night for **all volunteers** will be at TCU Place Centennial Hall A (lower level) on Friday, May 28 beginning at 7:00 p.m. Confirm your registration and receive your T-shirt. At 7:30 p.m. we'll hear a brief welcoming message and event overview. At around 8:00 or 8:15 p.m. volunteers will break into various training areas.

Race Expo & Package Pick-Up: Saturday May 29 from 10 am – 5 pm (TCU Place, 35 - 22nd St. E)
Take advantage of the free bike valet service in front of TCU Place. Concession is open.

Marathon: Sunday May 30 from 7 am – 1 pm (Start/Finish line at Henk Ruys Soccer Centre, 219 Primrose Drive)

Participant Identification by coloured bibs:

- **Marathon** participants wear **RED**
- **Half-Marathon** participants wear **GREEN**
- **10 km** participants wear **BLUE**
- **Marafun** participants wear **YELLOW**
- **Pace Bunnies** wear **ORANGE**

Marathon Planning Committee members are wearing **red** jackets with 'Race Committee' across the back. These individuals are available to help answer your questions.

Please wear your green volunteer t-shirt at all Marathon events for ease of identification. If it's cool outside, consider wearing your tee over a jacket or a sweater.

Please bring with you:

- **Comfortable shoes (a must for every volunteer!)**
- Hat (if outside)
- Sunscreen / bug spray (if outside)
- **Rain gear / umbrella** (if outside, please keep dry)
- **Windproof jacket / hoodie / blanket** (if outside, dress warm for colder weather)
- Folding chair or stool (if outside)
- Snacks
- Water bottle or coffee travel mug
- Your cell phone
- Money (there's a Saskatoon Lions Speed Skating Pancake Breakfast from 8:00 a.m. – Noon; \$5 for 3 pancakes & a hot drink. All proceeds to the Club and its athletes)

Key Emergency Personnel:
